

We are finishing the school year with a history topic. We will be finding out about **George Stephenson** and **Amelia Earhart**.



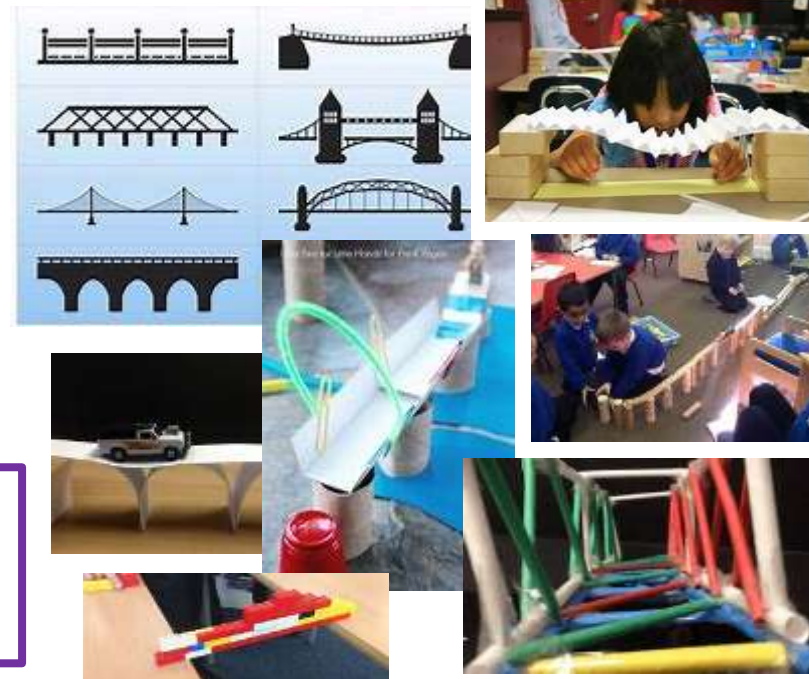
**George Stephenson** - He was a self-made mechanical engineer. He was credited for building the first railway line. He developed the 'Rocket' an early train.
