We encourage reading for pleasure, offering every child and young person the opportunity to choose a book from the library to complement their targeted reading book. During the day, children are introduced to a huge range of texts and all classes have sessions where books are read to them.

Our top tip: remember, reading comes in many forms, from audio books to graphic novels, poetry to comics. It can be solitary or social. And you can read wherever you want!
