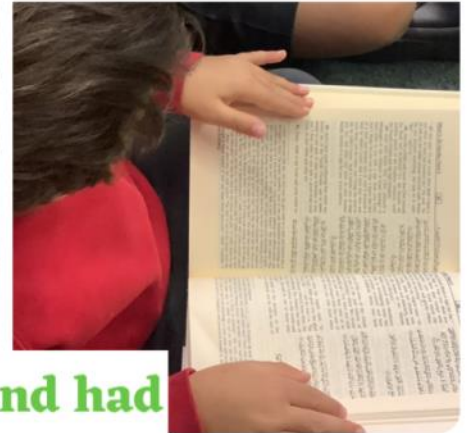

Reception have been learning about the Qur'an in our RE lessons.

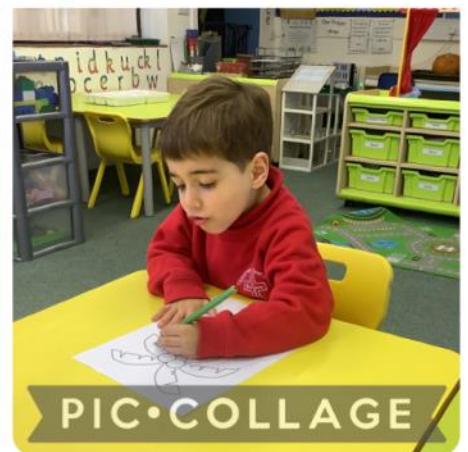


We washed our hands and had a look at the Qur'an.

We thought about the message the story was trying to teach us.



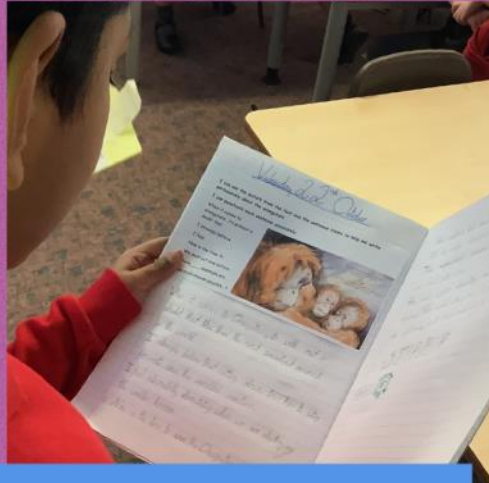

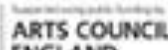
