Project Planet—End of Term Production—15/7
Each family has been issued with two tickets for each performance at 1.30 pm & 5.30 pm in the school hall. Due to fire regulations we can only issue two tickets per family for each performance. The side gate by Mr Gromski's office will be open from 1.15 pm to allow parents to enter the hall from the rear of the building. Children should return to school at 5pm. School will be locked until this time so please do not arrive before as staff will be out of school having tea in between performances. Please do not forget your tickets, they will be collected from you on arrival. We will keep a waiting list in the office of spare tickets wanted, and distribute them as people return them to us because they are not needed. Siblings from other settings will need their own ticket and seat. Pre school children will not need a ticket if they sit on a parent's knee. We kindly ask that you do not bring prams into the school hall as there will be no room for these. The New Village Hall Car Park is available during the 1.30 pm performance but in the evening it is in use by classes that have been booked in the hall.

Sports Day 04/07
Please send children into school on Friday 4th July in their full school PE Kit (black shorts/skort/cycling shorts and Tibberton logo red PE T-Shirt) wearing pumps or trainers. Please apply sunscreen at home in the morning and ensure children have a refillable water bottle and a hat in school. At 1.15 pm parents may come through the side gate by Mr Gromski's office to the right of the playground (as you face it) and come through to the field area. Races will start promptly at 1.30 pm. Any help to marshal the finish line on the day will be most welcome. Children will be dismissed as normal from the front playground by their class teachers at 3.15 pm. Please feel free to bring deckchairs and picnic blankets to sit on if you don't want to sit on the grass. We hope that the Friends PTA will be selling cold drinks on the day so please ensure you have small change handy.

Tibberton School Fete 28/6—2-4 pm
This year you will need a ticket for your child/siblings to attend the summer Fete. It will be £5 for a pre-paid ticket or £6 on the day. For that price your child will get unlimited access to the bouncy castle plus 7 other free activities/games accumulating in an item of their choice from the toy/white elephant stall. There will still be some stalls which require payment for such as the BBQ/bar/ice cream van/refreshments/candyfloss/bottle tombola. Adults do not require a ticket.
