She is famous for making important changes to hospitals and making them better places.

She was called 'The Lady with the Lamp', because she used to check on her patients at night.

Mary Seacole

Born - Jamaica (23.11.1805)

Job - Nurse

Lived in - Jamaica

Died - 14.5.1881 aged 75



Mary loved to travel.

She travelled to the **Crimean War**.

Mary set up a 'hotel' to help soldiers who had been hurt in the war.

She was very brave and rode on horseback to help soldiers who were hurt.

What does a nurse do?

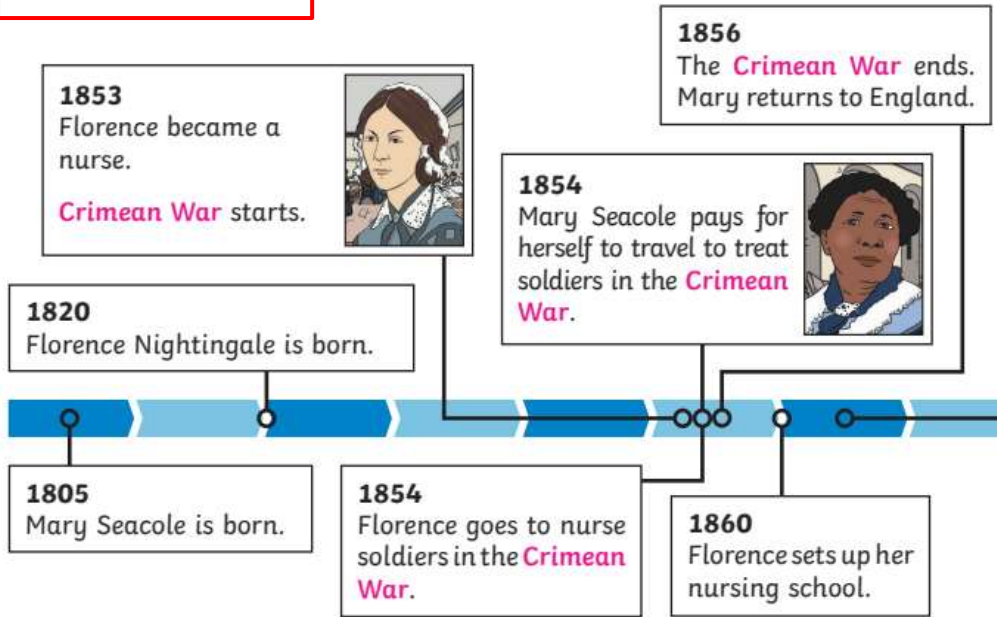
Can you find out what Mary Seacole was called by the soldiers. Why do you think they called her what they did?
