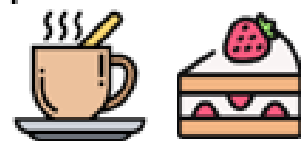
This is a huge opportunity for Friends of Tibberton to raise money for our school that will make a big impact. In the previous 2 years we have made more than £3500!

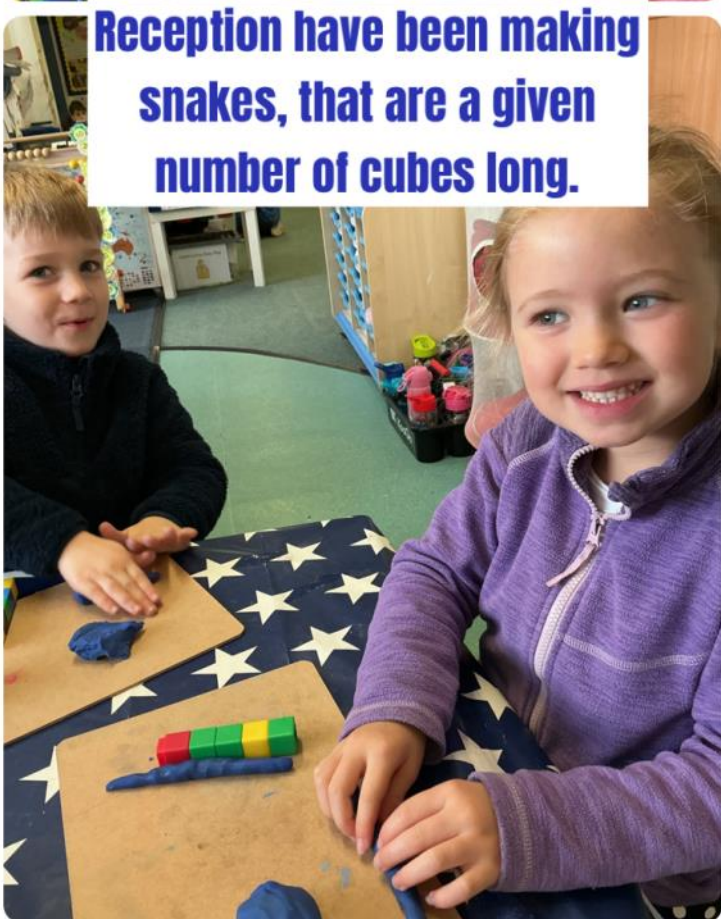

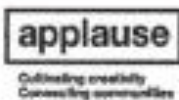
