Easter Service Friday 27/3

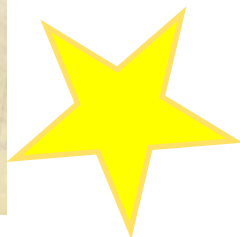

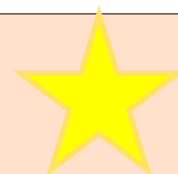

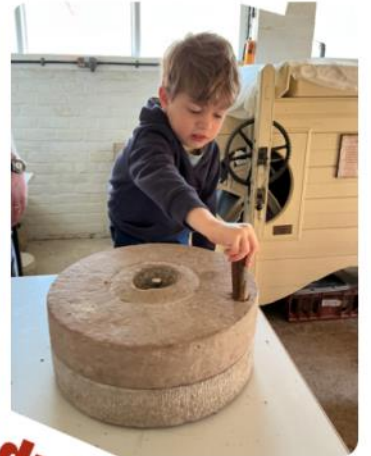
