Ask an adult to help you find the Swiggle website. See if you can find out some information on houses in the past.



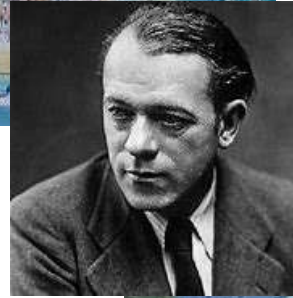
We are going to be looking out for signs of Spring. The weather should start to get better, leaves begin to grow, you may see some baby animals around and the days get longer.
