Coats

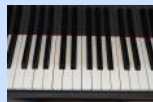
Please ensure children have a coat in school every day. The weather is variable and not consistently warm enough for children to not have coats.

School Attendance

As you know improving and maintaining good attendance is a National focus in school. Currently our whole school attendance stands at **96.3%** where the National, in all schools is currently reported as **94.6%**. We celebrate good attendance and have a duty to follow up any concerns. Following our termly analysis I would like to draw your attention to our attendance policy which is on our website. Our records show that **38%** of children have had leave in term time this year. Whilst this is for a variety of reasons, I would like to request that where possible this is avoided. 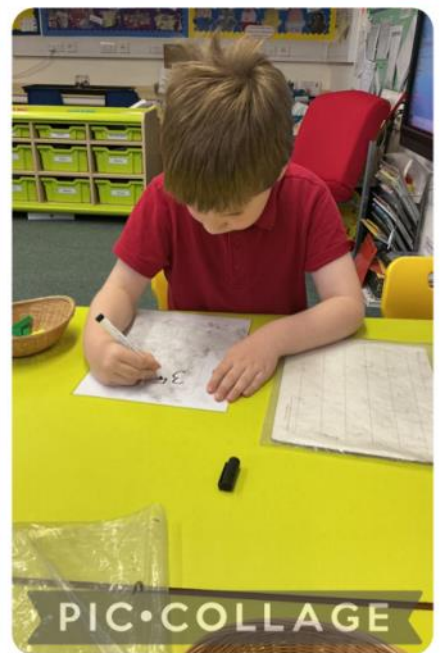

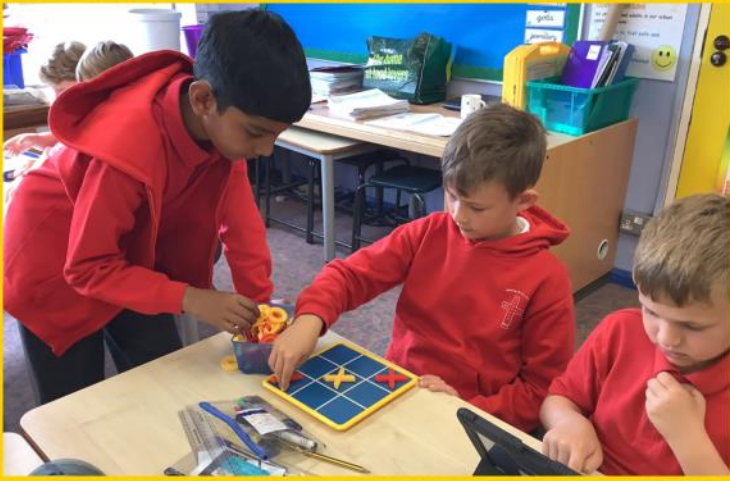
