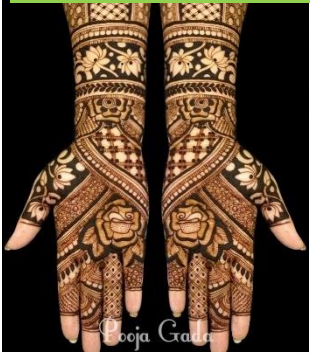


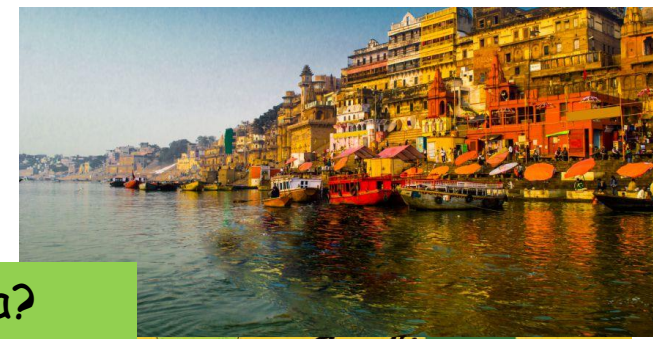

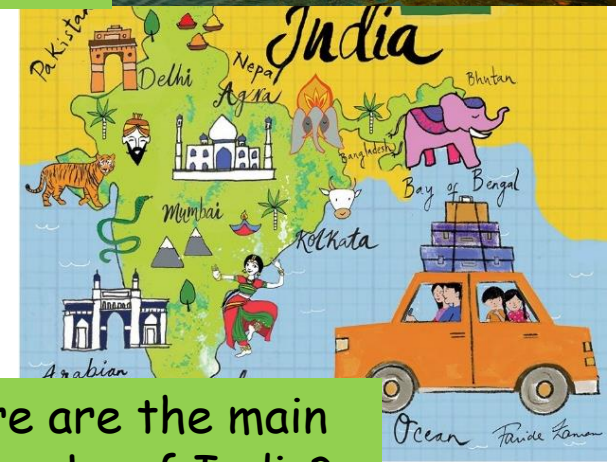
The National Bird of India is the Peacock. Peacocks are a symbol of grace, pride and beauty.
