Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club bills for July, for non leavers—will be going home on Friday 17th July. Please ensure your bill is paid by September when we return to school. Breakfast Club is open from 7.45 am on 3/9, invoices are issued at the end of each month. £5 from 7.45 am or £2.50 from 8.15 am. We stop serving breakfast at 8.15 am and children go out to play at 8.35 am in the front playground where they are supervised by a teacher.

Forms, Forms, Forms

At the beginning of every school year I bombard you with a few forms and you are all fantastic at getting them back to me.

- 1) Data Collection forms will come home on the first day of school. This is a summary of the key details we hold for your child. If you are happy all is correct then please tick and sign and return to me. If you have changes to make, then please amend in a bright pen and sign and return to me. I will then update our computer systems.
- 2) Educational Visits—this allows us to take your children on local trips around the village without having to ask your permission every time. Please return to me signed (with your child's name clearly printed so I don't have to guess) - thank you.
- 3) Swimming Consent for Y3&4—this will begin on 14/9—please return this form by then for your child to take part.

Y4 Residential 2027

The Y4 Residential next year will take place over 3 days 5-7th May. We estimate the cost to be £270. We cannot confirm exact costs until the coach is booked. We will then send out letters. In light of the expense, we have put this on P4S early to allow parents to pay over 9 months—July to March inclusive, £30 per month. We hope this helps, rather than wait for letters in October.

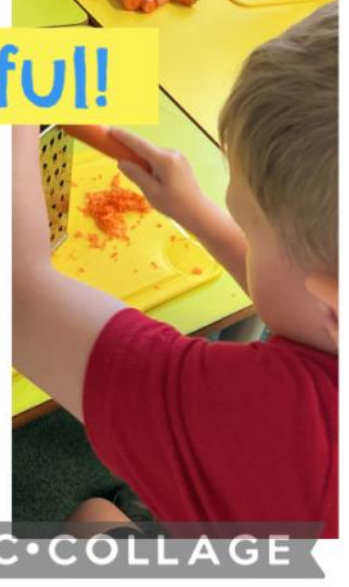

Cyber Prevent

Growing up in a digital world, many young people are incredibly comfortable with technology. This can lead to curiosity about how it all works – and sometimes, how it can be manipulated. What might start as harmless fun, like hacking into a game, can easily escalate into illegal activities such as data theft, ransomware, or Distributed Denial of Service (DDoS) attacks.

The Cyber Choices programme was created to help people make informed choices and to use their cyber skills in a legal way.

The aims of the programme are:

- Explaining the difference between legal and illegal cyber activity
- Encouraging individuals to make informed choices in their use of technology
- Increasing awareness of the Computer Misuse Act 1990
- Promoting positive, legal cyber opportunities

The Regional Cyber Prevent Team can deliver bespoke Cyber Choices training sessions to safeguarding leads in schools, colleges and local Policing teams across the region to help them understand the risk and threat posed by the unethical / illegal use of technology by young persons. The average age of a cyber criminal currently is just 16 years old. We also have a referral system and can work on a one to one basis with a person to help turn their activities away from the risk of cyber crime and into positive pathways.
