

## Tibberton CE First School SEND Core Offer

At Tibberton we aim to give all our children access to a broad and balanced, engaging, active education. We are dedicated to giving all our children the opportunity to experience the highest quality education we can offer. Each class receives teaching of the highest level and is well equipped to aid the delivery of high quality teaching in all areas of the curriculum. As a result there is often very little requirement for external intervention.

This being said, we acknowledge that some children have more complex needs that cannot be effectively met through their daily education and that these children require additional and in some cases, specialist support. In such cases the school implements specifically designed programmes of support to allow them to make progress in their learning. If a child is struggling to maintain the average level of progress this does not mean that they have special needs.

Where a child is identified as experiencing difficulties accessing the curriculum we aim to adapt their work to better suit their learning styles and support their needs.

A child's learning may be met through a range of methods or support including;

- Support within the classroom by a teaching assistant or teacher led group.
- A small focus group targeting specific support or needs.
- 1:1 support in extreme cases

Children who hold a statement of Special Educational Needs or who may be eligible for an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) may receive a higher level of 1:1 support by dedicated support staff.
