Maths lessons were well organised and built strong foundations, while offering the right balance of challenge and support. Children worked independently, used resources confidently, and spoke enthusiastically about what they were learning. They took real pride in their work and showed excellent focus throughout lessons. The advisor also noted how well staff know their pupils and adapt learning to meet individual needs, ensuring all children are supported to succeed. (The books are a collection rather than a series, so they can be read in any order.)

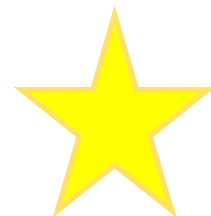

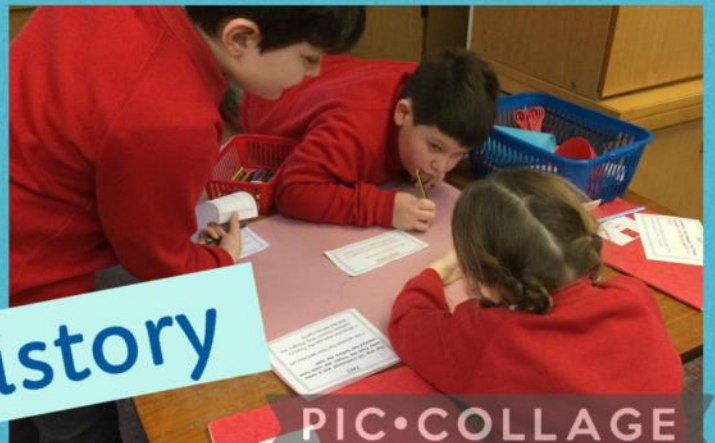
